 - g. Proposed by Fred Cafasso to address the Gledhill traffic light and Edith Ave traffic light at Broadway. The crosswalk light operates by itself and changes the light causing a backup even when no one is there. You can't walk on the other side of the street due to the construction in front of the old St Theresa's Church. Also we need to stay vigilant with the no turn on red signs at Chelsea St at Broadway, Broadway northbound at Ferry, and Ferry St at Broadway by the gas station please. Also the school signage specifically Oakes St, Tufts Ave area. I am aware of the inclement weather via snow has slowed this process.
