

Meeting of June 28, 2018

- The Commission discussed a date to change the historical pictures of Everett, found outside the City Clerk's Office. The Chairman will ask the City Clerk if there's a possibility of accomplishing this on a Friday, preferably on July 6, 2018.
- It was decided not to initiate any new activities, at this time.
- Under Old Business, the Commission again discussed coordinating the Veteran's Day Observance and honoring Lt. Joseph Wehner together, in November. The Chairman will contact Mr. Philbin, in the Mayor's Office, to discuss this. Also, we will ask Commission member Patricia Ells to research the life of Lt. Wehner and see if she can locate any pictures of him.
- Under Old Business, the Commission again discussed launching an ECTV program about Everett memories. Episode subjects could include what life was like in Everett during WWII, Prominent Everett High Football Teams, Life in Everett's Neighborhoods, Life in Everett during the Viet Nam War.
- Under New Business – the Chairman informed members that he received an email from Marzie Galazka, from the Planning Dept. regarding any objections the Commission might have regarding the rehabilitation of Joseph Kearns Park. Because there is nothing of historical consequence in the park, the Commission holds no objections to any work done there.
