LICENSING BOARD MINUTES

March 9, 2020

Meeting called to order. Present were Chairman Phil Antonelli, Board Member Phil Arloro., & Detective Michael Lavey, Detective Al Sabella and Annette DeBilio, Clerk

1. Joey's Bar and Grill, is no longer on Ferry St and is now in the process of looking for a new location. The Chairman requested that Joey come back up for the June 8th meeting to give the Board an update. At that time if he has not found a new location he will have to turn the alcohol license in and once he does find a location he will have to apply for a new license.
2. Transfer of Full Alcohol License from Sathan Enterprises DBA 7-Eleven, 543 Ferry St to DU Foods, DBA 7-Eleven. The Board voted and approved the transfer. 0 days - 2 years
3. Joe Messina appeared for an event that he will be having on April 19 at the Silver Fox. The Board approved the event with the stipulation that he hires a police detail.
4. Yaqueline Cruz from Mama Santos *Café* appeared to ask if she can open until 1:00 AM. The Chairman explained that she is to close at 12AM and in July she can appear before the Board again to review if there have been any problems and the Board will make their decision at that time. She then asked if she could stay open until 12AM on Thursday evenings and the Board approved her request.
5. Tabled from February, Nirani, Inc DBA Zuzu Momo, 291 Main St, applied for a New Full Alcohol License. In February the Board had concerns the restaurant not having waitresses for table service. The partners of Zuzu Momo changed their business plan and decided to have a full wait staff. The Board did have concerns about proper training. The Board voted and approved the License with stipulations. The hours will be Sunday to Saturday 11 AM to 12 AM for the first 6 months. Prior to

the license being issued once approved by the ABCC all building, electric, plumbing and gas permits must be signed off. The Board would also like to see their standard operating procedures.
