- After a review of the plans for the former St. Therese property, as presented by the Malden Redevelopment Authority and HOME Investment Partnerships Program, the Everett Historical Commission reviewed the Memorandum of Agreement between the Malden Redevelopment Authority and the Massachusetts Historical Commission regarding St. Therese Senior Apartments and unanimously accepted said agreement. We discussed the creation of a park, located on the corner of Stevenson Avenue and Broadway that would memorialize the history of the former St. Therese Parish, for future generations of Everett citizens.
