Max Durena founded UISL in 2012, it strives to be an all inclusive soccer league which reaches players across a diverse spectrum. UISL welcomes those new to soccer, former youth players and even advanced competitors. The program is built on experienced and professional staff members. UISL wants its members to leave feeling satisfied and energized after an eventful game day.

President Max Durena and Vice President Oscar Dupervil have met various times with Mayor Carlo DeMaria to thank him for allowing the program to use the City's local soccer fields.
