CITY OF EVERETT HOSTS PUBLIC MEETING FOR REDESIGN OF GRAMSTORF PARK *Another example of Mayor DeMaria's ongoing initiative for renovation and development*

On Monday, January 30th Mayor Carlo DeMaria and the Department of Planning and Development hosted a public meeting to discuss the redesign of Gramstorf Park "Little Flo" (corner of Nichols & Florence Street).

Several concept plans were presented for public feedback. The proposed amenities include new playground equipment, new seating areas, a new splash pad, additional landscaping, and upgrades to the existing basketball court.

This project is one of many parks that Mayor DeMaria has targeted for renovation, development, and asset preservation within the City. One of the Mayor's goals is to keep all recreational areas and green spaces current, safe, and well maintained in order to retain our City's value.

Mayor DeMaria stated, "Gramstorf Park is one of many parks and tot lots around the City that has or will receive updates and renovations.
