EVERETT, MA. – Everett Chief of Police Steven A. Mazzie announced the passing of Patrol Officer Thomas Goyetche on Tuesday March 21, 2017, following a brief illness.

Chief Mazzie said: "Officer Tom Goyetche was an easy going approachable individual which made him a lot of friends over the past 28 years. He will be missed by his family and friends."

Thomas Goyetche graduated from the Somerville Police Academy in 1989. He served in the patrol division and also was a detective in the 1990's before returning to the uniform patrol division.

Thomas Goyetche is survived by his wife Maureen and his brother Everett Police Department Patrolman Andrew Goyetche and other family members.
