EPD ARRESTS MAN ON FIREARM CHARGES.

August 22, 2017

EVERETT, MA. – Everett Chief of Police Steven A. Mazzie announced the arrest of an individual on multiple firearms charges.

On Sunday August 20, 2017 Patrol Officers Santiago Flores and Carlos Membreno responded to a Ferry Street address for a reported returned stolen motor vehicle. The officers, along with Patrol Officers Michele Basteri and Lauren Pagliuca encountered an individual involved with the stolen motor vehicle. The individual was detained and a search of his backpack resulted in the seizure of a firearm.

Arrested without incident was Ramon Berberena, age 26 of Malden Ma. He was charged with Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, Possession of a Firearm with Defaced Serial Number, Unlawful Possession of Ammunition and Using a Motor Vehicle Without Authority.

The suspect was arraigned in Malden District Court on Monday August 21. All subjects arrested by the Everett Police Department are presumed to be innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
