



COVID-19 VACCINATION UPDATE

Mayor DeMaria is pleased to announce that the Everett Health Department will be administering the COVID-19 vaccine to Everett Residents over the age of 75*, ages 65 +, residents and staff of low-income housing or affordable senior housing, or those with two or more comorbidities, on February 20th, 2021.

**Per Governor Baker's order, caregivers who accompany seniors 75+ to their appointment are also eligible to receive the vaccine. Appointments for both individuals are required.*

REQUIREMENTS:

- Clinic is designated for Everett residents ages 75+ only.
- Caregivers are not required to be 75+
