C0056-11 Resolution/s/Councilors Sergio Cornelio, Carlie Smith and Jason Marcus-To have all companies that do work for the City of Everett E-Verity (the voluntary program run by the U.S. Government) to help certify that employees hired by companies are legal residents and legally authorized to work in the United States. Invited: Sponsors.
2. A0146-11 Ordinance/s/Alderman Michael K. Marchese-To revoke Ordinance Number A0150-09, an Ordinance authorizing a "fully empowered Traffic Commission". Invited: Sponsor.
3. A0147-11 Ordinance/s/Aldermen Robert J. Van Campen, Michael K. Marchese, L. Charles DiPerri, and Councilor Rosa DiFlorio-That there be enacted a residency ordinance applicable to all public safety employees hired by the City of Everett on or after January 1, 2012. Invited: Sponsors.

C0060-11 Order/s/Councilor Sergio Cornelio, as President-To petition the Great and General Court to enable legislation for an act authorizing the City of Everett to establish a linkage fee revolving fund. To be used for the maintenance of streets, parks and public recreational facilities within the City and the Mayor shall administer the funds for said purposes. Invited: Mayor, as Sponsor.

C0113-11 Order/s/Councilors David Rodrigues, Daniel Napolitano and Adam Ragucci-That the City of Everett amend or establish all necessary ordinances in order to establish fines directed at the owners and caregivers of nuisance properties – that is, properties that have received numerous police complaints within a stated time period and continue to cause issues in neighborhoods. Invited: Sponsors.
6. A0132-11 Order/s/Alderman Michael K. Marchese-To prohibit all non-profit, tax exempt organizations from coming into the City of Everett and purchasing property without first coming to the Board of Aldermen for approval, and that a moratorium preventing same be put into effect for a one-year period. Invited: Sponsor.
7. A0156-11 Order/s/Alderman Joseph McGonagle-To petition the State Legislature authorizing the City to adopt an act regarding a special law granting authority to the Everett Traffic Commission to have the power to lower speed limits within the City of Everett. Invited: Sponsor.
8. A0163-11 Ordinance/s/Alderman Robert Van Campen-To enact a zoning ordinance defining and restricting the proper location and placement of any home-base satellite dish and/or device on one's property. (Satellite and Microwave Antennas). Invited: Sponsor.
